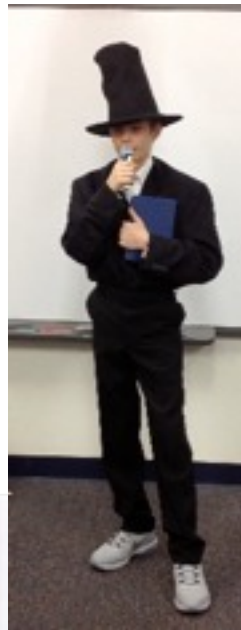
Accounts: Eanes teachers can set up student accounts under the teacher's Weebly account

Book Log: Students can document their reading with book reviews, summaries, or book trailers

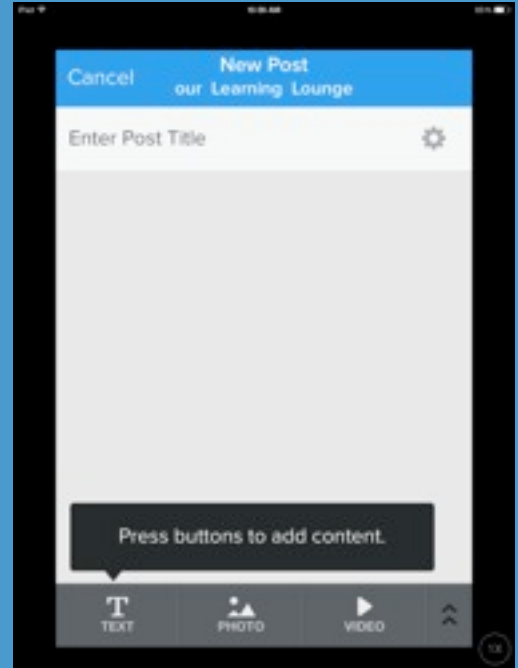
History: Students write blog posts from the point of view of someone from the past

Art Gallery: Post pictures of a work in progress and the finished product

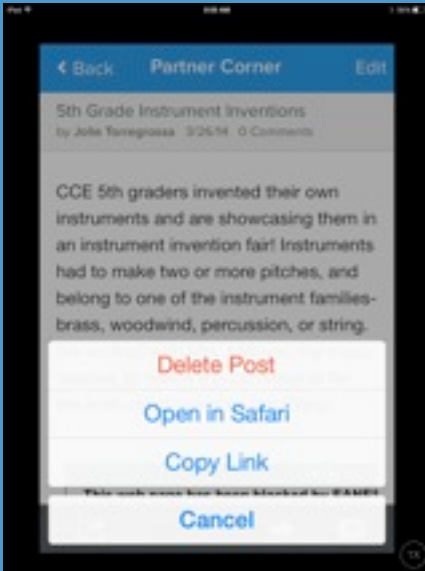
App Smash: Use the links to your Weebly blog to create Thinglinks
